PROJECT MANAGERS

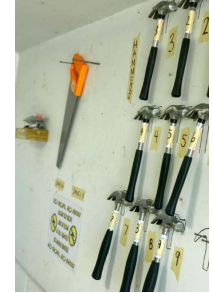
Our mission - to lead by designing and constructing useful items for Stanhope Road School.

S.W.A.T TEAM (Students who advance technology)



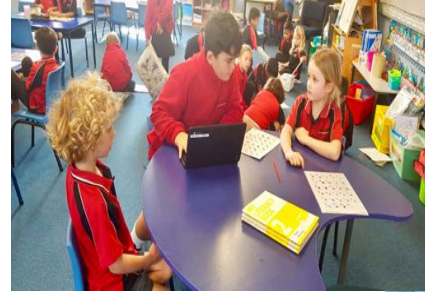
Our mission - to lead by teaching and trouble-shooting in a digital capacity.

- Promo movie profiling leadership in Hautūtanga

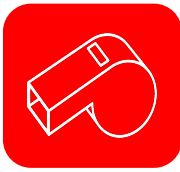


"It gives me an opportunity to show all the families at home all the learning we are doing and how we are becoming leaders."
