School Attendance



TACKLING TECHNOLOGY


Tackling Technology Parent Evening on Wednesday 11 March, at 6pm.

TEAM TALK – Whakatōtanga

We have had a brilliant start to 2020 in Whakatōtanga!

We are very excited to launch our new Learning Through Play programme! It is called Tūhuratanga Tāima which means a time to discover and investigate. We want Tūhuratanga Tāima to

preserve the childrens' natural sense of wonder and curiosity. It endeavours to provide an environment where the learners feel safe to try new things and to share their ideas.

The Whakatōtanga teachers work hard to provide open



ended learning opportunities for the children to explore. These invitations and provocations are developed through noticing the childrens' interests or urges. They encourage the learners to think, create and problem solve. We want them to be challenged while learning persistence and resilience. They encourage the learners to participate and contribute in ways appropriate to their stage of development. This cooperation, collaboration and negotiation will develop a strong sense of confidence and belonging.

We constantly look for ways the children can demonstrate the national 'Key Competencies', our school and team values and the learning areas of the New Zealand Curriculum. Our 'Key Competency' focus for Term 1 is **Relating to Others**.

The big understandings we want the learners to gain this term are:

- I treat others as I like to be treated
- I take turns and share
- I let other people join in
- I can show respect and understand that others may be different from me
- I can be patient and help others
- I actively listen and respond when someone is talking to me

We are hoping that in the future the Tūhuratanga Tāima programme will be infused with digital technologies. Let's nurture student led, hands on learning that develops oral language and deep thinking!
