Fume and spume and spondrift spray

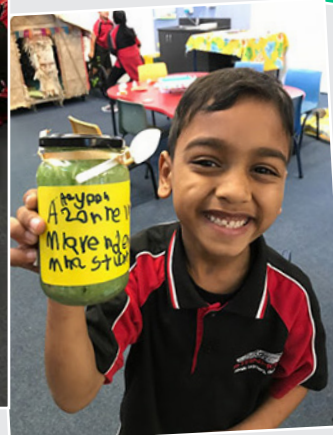
Fizzle swizzle shout hooray
