**Parent Group Support:** Thank you to our amazing Parent Group who once again have continued to work tirelessly for our school and students. This year the funds they have raised contributed to the new swimming pool fencing, astro turf on the courts and the PA sound system that will shortly be installed in the canopy.

**Use of Facilities:** As a school we aim to give our students, staff and community the best facilities possible that they can be proud of. In 2020 we have completed the following projects: Jenny Bristow Sports Court and Canopy; three new astro turf surfaces; swimming pool fencing; Junior Courtyard development; installation of Values Pencils; Tremendous Outdoor Classroom; library breakout space and new carpet; junior school breakout learning space. By the end of the year we will have finished the learning support breakout space in the old dental clinic and astro turf behind the swimming pool.


